WHO CAN ENTER?

The everywoman in Transport & Logistics Awards are for those who possess the qualities, attitude, hard work ethic and commitment to supporting other women that makes them a credit to the industry and the organisations they work for. They are the talented women who have exceeded expectations as well as inspired success in others.

The awards are open to women at all stages of their career.

Entrants can either nominate themselves or be nominated by someone else, they can enter a maximum of two categories and must:

- work within a transport or logistics role
- be based or have their chief operations in the UK or Ireland (exception: International Inspiration Award)
- be available for a virtual judging day on 20 April 2023 and the awards ceremony in London on 28 June 2023

JUDGING PROCESS:

- All successful entrants will be contacted in March 2023 and told if they will be required to attend Judging Day
- If selected, the Awards ceremony takes place on 28 June in London. Attendance at the Awards is a condition of entry.
- There will be one winner per category as well as one recipient of the Woman of the Year Award.
- All decisions regarding the judging process are made by our independent judging panel. The everywoman team do not influence this process.
- The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into before or after the judging.
- Due to the large number of nominations received, the judging panel are unable to provide individual feedback.
